

Hygiene improvements provide stress relief during pandemic

During COVID, the remote learning period provided schools with an opportunity to reassess their hygiene practices and prepare for the eventual return of staff and students.

Sandringham Secondary College in bayside Melbourne made an astute decision to upgrade all their washrooms and hand washing areas throughout the school. Sandringham College Principal Amy Porter, emphasised that the safety of the whole college community was the priority.
