Why a welcoming washroom environment matters

A well-thought-through washroom environment helps employees feel comfortable and cared for throughout the working day. On the other hand, untidy and poorly designed washrooms can be a reason why employees are reluctant to come in to work.

Privacy as a priority

Sharing washrooms with co-workers can be uncomfortable, privacy becomes essential to feeling safe and at ease. Employees should never worry about being overheard or interrupted in washroom settings. Strong privacy features help build trust and create a workplace where people can focus on their work without distractions from a negative washroom experience.

Meeting a wide range of needs

Today's workplaces bring together people with a wide range of needs, sensitivities and circumstances. Washrooms should reflect that diversity, supporting neurodivergent employees, those with hygiene sensitivities and individuals facing different physical or personal challenges. Designing new washrooms or equipping existing ones with inclusive hygiene products, such as period care products, ensures that more people feel understood and accommodated.



Main reasons for not using the washrooms at work¹:

- 46% find washrooms unhygienic and/or messy
- 29% report no toilet paper and/or soap available
- 29% dislike sharing washrooms with others
- 26% feel uncomfortable when someone has just used the washroom
- 24% feel washrooms lack privacy
- 18% find washrooms busy most of the time
- 13% worry about colleagues using the washroom directly after them
- 11% struggle to find the time
- 10% find washrooms are located too far away

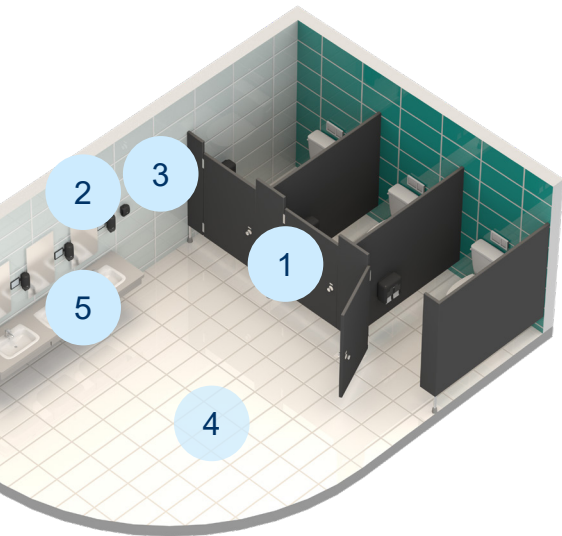

Act now:

1. Privacy is important – install floor-to-ceiling stall doors.
2. Make sure that you refill the soap dispensers with hypoallergenic soap – for employees and visitors with sensitive skin or eczema.
3. Touch-free intuitive dispensers create a hygienic experience and are preferred by employees and visitors who have hygiene concerns.
4. Let washroom visitors know when the washroom was last cleaned. Cleaning frequency is important – make sure to clean often when the traffic is high especially during peak times. This also helps avoid run-outs. Pay special attention to floors – these are often the most contaminated area of the washroom.
5. High-capacity dispensers and data-driven cleaning can help prevent unexpected run-outs.
