

Tork cleaning for Industry checklist

Washroom and Changing Room Cleaning



Put on protective gloves and attire. Wear gloves for cleaning procedures. Gloves should be discarded after each cleaning. If using re-usable gloves, they should be dedicated for cleaning and disinfecting surfaces of certain zones in the working area.
Empty rubbish and recycling bins – replace liners and make sure to sanitise inside and outside of the waste bins as needed.
Clean and sanitise all high-touch surfaces with a soap and registered disinfectant product. Use a new wiper for each area to reduce cross-contamination.
Restock all dispensers to ensure proper hygiene and handwashing practices can be achieved.
Mop the floor, with special attention to areas around the toilets and sinks. To reduce cross-contamination consider disposable cleaning options
